

WHAT TO BRING WITH TO KENNELS

1. **FOOD:** We have two prices for boarding, one to include our food (Montego) or you can supply food. If you supply food, please clearly mark your containers with your dog's name and state amounts/cups to be fed per meal.
Kindly don't bring a 20kg bag of food for a 3-day stay 😊 space is limited in our kitchen. We do have freezer space for those wanting to feed raw diet.
2. **BEDDING:** We do supply bedding, but we prefer that you bring your pets own bedding (as it's nice to have something from home) but please be advised that we do not take responsibility if they chew it up. There is much excitement at playtimes and dogs tend to get frustrated whilst awaiting their turn to go out at playtimes and sometimes this is when they chew up their beds. Also, sometimes overnight some pups tend to have foam parties, but we never get invited 😊.
3. **TOYS:** You are welcome to bring some of your dog's favourite toys with but we do not accept responsibility if they get left behind. Sometimes in all the excitement of going home, we and the owners forget to grab the toys. Please make sure you have everything with you that you brought with.
4. **LEASHES:** Only dogs that have never been to us before need to leave their leashes here. If you have been before kindly take your leashes home with you, less for us to worry about getting lost accidentally.
5. **BOWLS:** We supply stainless bowls for both food and water so no need to bring your own bowls. We can supply plastic bowls if your pet is afraid of the noise of metal bowls. We wash both water and food bowls twice daily therefore can't stack all different shapes of bowls on our basin to dry. Ours all fit nicely into each other.
6. **MEDICATION:** We can administer any medication that your pet may require. Please ensure that it is clearly marked with your pet's name and dosages and that there is enough medication to last their entire stay.
7. **VACCINATION CARDS:** We would prefer you email or WhatsApp your vaccinations when you make the booking. We do not keep the cards onsite as many times both us and the owner forget to take them when they go home.
8. **FIRST TIME CLIENTS:** Please try and bring your pets in the morning hours for their first stay. Many owners think that it's better to bring in their pets just before we close so they can spend more time at home, but this is in fact so bad for them. They are already going to be nervous for their first hour or two till we can settle them in, so bringing them in late gives us no time to settle your pets in properly then we close for the evening, and they then are left overnight in a new place which makes it harder for them to settle. Pets brought in early settle quickly and meet us all.
